Exploration of the Paca Garden bridge over water lily pond
Sponge painting to create an impressionistic picture of the pond

Afternoon Overview of Annapolis History with Discover Annapolis trolley
Patriot: William Paca
Tour of William Paca House
Campers meet William Paca and Cook
Campers help Cook make ice cream & have ice cream party

June 22

Morning Illustrator: Eric Carle
Reading of Carle's *The Very Hungry Caterpillar*
Exploration of the life cycle of a caterpillar
Exploring Eric Carle's tissue paper collages
Making of an egg carton caterpillar using Carle's technique

Afternoon Patriot: Samuel Chase
Introduction to architecture
Architectural walking tour
Make gingerbread houses

June 23

Morning Painter: Georgia O'Keeffe
Reading of *Through Georgia's Eyes*
Exploration of the parts of a flower
Children will create a large flower in the spirit of O'Keeffe's abstract flowers

Afternoon Sail on the Schooner *Woodwind*
Patriot: Marquis de Lafayette, troops on Eastport peninsula
Patriot: Annapolis townspeople, burning of the *Peggy Stewart*
Capture the Flag in Paca Garden

June 24

Morning Painter: Van Gogh
Reading of *Camille and the Sunflowers*
Exploration of Van Gogh's post impressionist technique
Children will create a painting of sunflowers

Afternoon Patriot: Jonas and Anne Catharine Green
Tour the Jonas and Anne Catharine Green house
Paper-making and printing activity

June 25

Morning Patriot and Painter: Charles Willson Peale
Tour the Hammond Harwood House

Afternoon Make portrait miniature
Campers install art exhibition at the Historic Annapolis Museum
Exhibition opening reception for parents

Session Two: 4st through 6rd graders, limit of 15 campers

July 12

Morning Painter: Faith Ringgold and Story Quilts
Dramatic reading of *Tar Beach*
Exploration of the Paca Garden
Each camper selects a garden landscape to draw
Transfer scenes to fabric squares for construction of story quilt

Afternoon Overview of Annapolis History with Discover Annapolis
Patriot: William Paca
Tour of William Paca House where campers will meet William Paca and Cook
Campers will help Cook make ice cream & have ice cream party

July 13

Morning Painter: Klee
Studying Klee's technique of expressionism
Students will create *magical* pictures of the fish in the Paca pond using both crayons and watercolors

Afternoon Patriot: Samuel Chase
Introduction to architecture
Architectural walking tour
Make gingerbread houses

July 14

Morning Painter: Picasso
Children will study cubism using paintings of Picasso and Braque
Children will create their own cubist picture of a photo of the Summer House
