




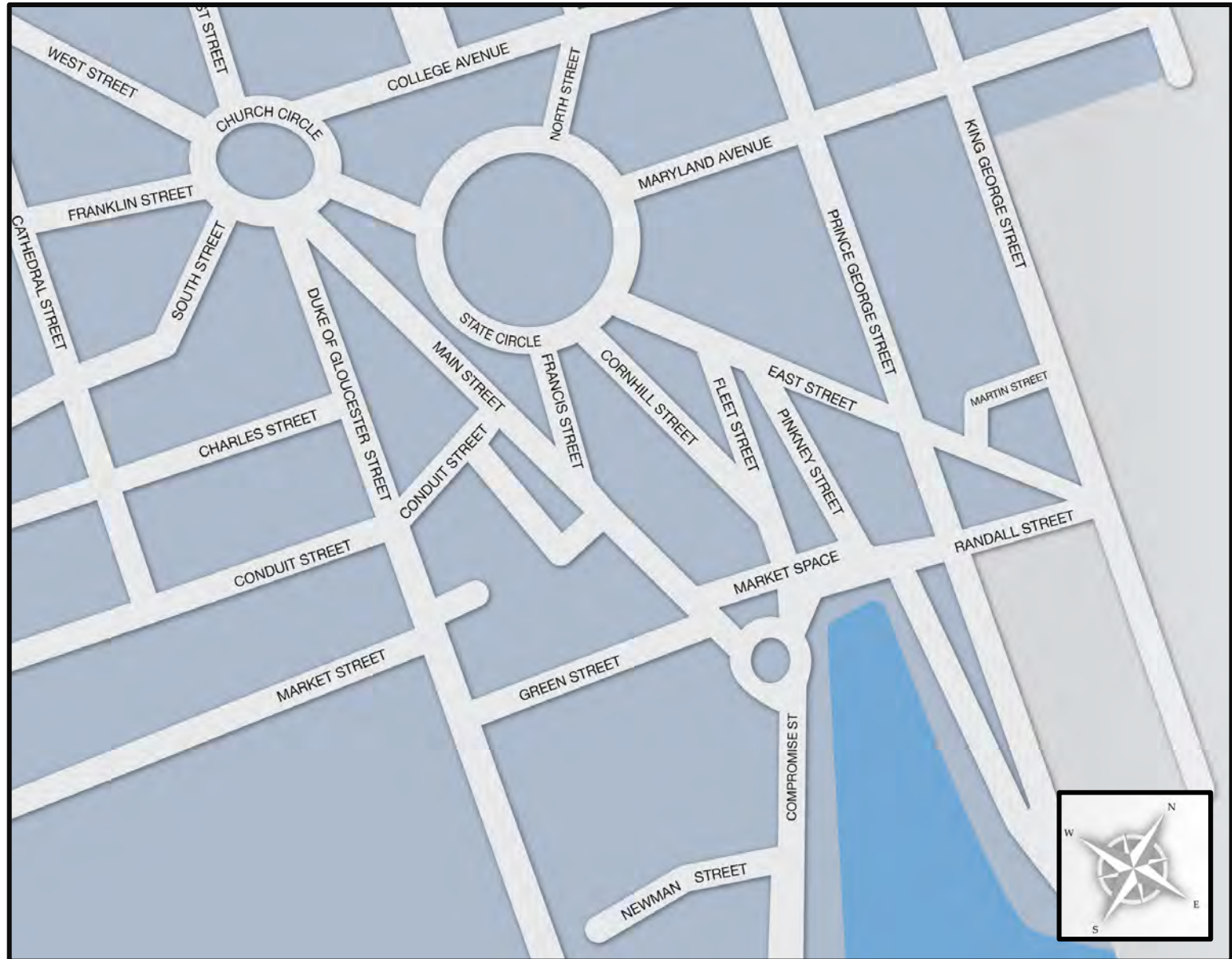


Find the Founders

Annapolis is the only city in the United States where you can view the homes of all the state's signers of the Declaration of Independence.

On the map, find each location based on the description. Draw the symbol in the correct spot.

-  Maryland State House – in State Circle
-  William Paca – North side of Prince George Street between East St and Maryland Ave
-  Samuel Chase – Southwest corners side of Maryland Ave and King George St
-  Charles Carroll of Carrollton – South side of Duke of Gloucester past Green St
-  Thomas Stone – South side of Hanover Rd between Maryland Ave and the end of the street
